



## **FedEx Hub Fact Sheet**

The new FedEx Mid-Atlantic Air Hub, a 470,000 square-foot facility state-of-the-art facility, operates at the Piedmont Triad International Airport. The hub is the fifth FedEx air hub built in the U.S. with the capacity to sort 24,000 packages per hour. Other air hubs are located in Memphis, Indianapolis, Anchorage, and Fort Worth. The Piedmont Triad location primarily serves East Coast destinations with packages originating on the East Coast for the East Coast. Currently, FedEx Express employs 520 people regionally.

The business advantages of having close proximity to the Piedmont Triad FedEx Hub are:

- Ability to meet higher customer service expectations
- Create a more ambitious inventory strategy
- Ship to and from a variety of domestic or worldwide locations
- Increased flexibility in shipping options

The FedEx Air Hub is estimated to create nearly 20,000 new jobs in a 14-county area over a 16-year period. Total new wages and salaries are projected at \$5.5 billion, with a total value-added impact of \$9.3 billion on the Triad's economy.

A central location and state-of-the-art facilities make the Piedmont Triad International Airport a catalyst for commercial and industrial development. PTIA is home to more than 50 companies and 4,000 employees. A new 9,000-foot runway opened in January 2010, providing three runways for freight and passenger travel. PTIA offers more than 650 acres in developable land to aviation-related companies seeking a Greensboro base for their operations.
