

Internet Backbone

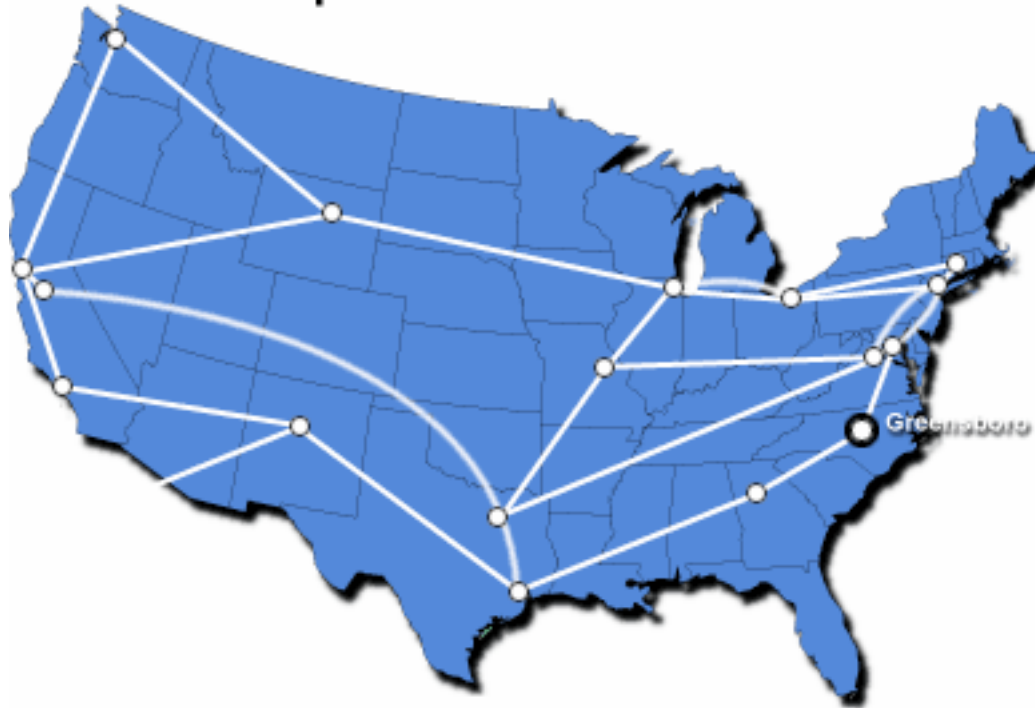
